


Symphonic Programs 2024-2025 Season







Dallas-based Skyland is an eclectic quintet trained in classical music, Celtic folk, and other styles.

Originally founded in 2008, we performed for 15 years under the name "5 Second Rule," appearing at Celtic festivals and pubs around the Southwest. In 2023 we rebranded ourselves as "Skyland" to seek out new audiences, create original music, and find fresh ways to blend our decades of multi-genre experience.

In December 2023, Skyland performed holiday shows with the **Richardson Symphony Orchestra**, and also with the **Turtle Creek Chorale** (along with **Celtic Woman** founding singer Chloë Agnew). We also appeared on the main stage at the **TCR Festival** in Waxahachie (now called the *Crossroads of Texas Country Festival*), where we'll perform again this October.

We have two exciting new programs for your consideration - a holiday show, and an oceanthemed Celtic show for any time of year. Our shows are flexible and easy to assemble with minimal rehearsal. Our instruments are wireless so we can move and connect with your audience!





Kat Glaze (fiddle) - Equally proficient as both classical violinist and traditional fiddler, Kat is in demand as a recording artist, pit musician, and stage performer in the D/FW area. Kat has also appeared onstage in several stage shows.



Ian Gill (vocals, guitar) - A skilled guitarist with a powerful tenor voice, Ian is Associate Music director at First United Methodist Church in Richardson and conductor of the Richardson Community Chorale.



David Lovrien (Irish whistles, saxophone) - Composer, music publisher, and musician with the Dallas Winds for over 30 years. His musical underscore for **Texas Country Reporter**'s "Texas Tribute" show toured 13 Texas symphonies in 2022.



Paul Dryer (mandolin, banjo, guitar) - Paul is a multi-instrumental talent well-known among the Irish music communities in Texas. He has over 40 years experience in jazz, rock, bluegrass, and gospel bands.



Rick Holt (percussion) - A master of the Irish frame drum (bodhrán), Rick is also an experienced composer and orchestrator. His *Celtic Mass* for choir, orchestra & folk instruments has been performed by several D/FW churches.

Ocean of Song

An evening of romance & adventure on the high seas

"Ocean of Song" is an original suite showcasing Skyland's vocal harmonies and instrumental skills, with sweeping, cinematic orchestral accompaniment. Musical styles and traditional melodies from multiple Celtic nations are incorporated - from Ireland and Scotland to Asturias and Galicia in northern Spain.

Other stand-alone arrangements can be added or used as encores, including the familiar *Skye Boat Song* (theme from TV's "Outlander") and *The Parting Glass*, a traditional Celtic farewell.

Ocean of Song is an original symphonic suite, composed and orchestrated by Skyland members David Lovrien and Rick Holt. Inspired by the 1911 poem, "The Ocean of Song" by Ella Wheeler Wilcox, it is both a song cycle and a concerto grosso for folk instruments & orchestra. Heartfelt ballads, cinematic moods, and stirring images of whalers, pirates, and sirens combine to tell a story of the irresistable allure of the sea.

A Celtic Christmas is a diverse program of holiday favorites, including traditional tunes from Ireland and Scotland.
